Chauchina is a municipality in the province of Granada. Its economy is traditionally based on irrigated agriculture and olive groves. The area combines a characteristic rural landscape with an active cultural and festive life. Approximate population: 5,600 inhabitants. Annual budget of the City Council: approx. 5.5 million euros.

The competition had an annual investment of €35,000, including travel expenses for local and international musicians, such as the Auburn University Marching Band (AUMB). Awards have also been given to international conductors such as Dutch composer Jacob de Haan in the 2019 edition.
